Sub: Re-Constitution of Environmental Cell Academic Year 2024-25

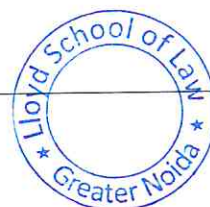

Terms of Reference

1. The Environmental Cell shall be re-constituted every three academic year, or as decided by the Director/Principal.
2. Meetings of the Environmental Cell shall be held at least once every semester.

Quorum: Presence of a minimum 50% of members will be the quorum.





Functions of the Environmental Cell

Subject to the existing provisions of the College and guidelines issued by the UGC/State Government/Parent University from time to time, the Environmental Cell shall:

1. Promote environmental awareness and sustainability practices among students, faculty, and staff.
2. Organise seminars, workshops, plantation drives, and awareness campaigns on environmental conservation.
3. Monitor and encourage responsible use of energy, water, and other natural resources within the campus.
4. Promote waste segregation, recycling, and reduction of plastic usage on campus.
5. Recommend and oversee green initiatives such as tree plantation, rainwater harvesting, and eco-friendly campus practices.
6. Coordinate with government bodies, NGOs, and other institutions for environment-related projects and programmes.
7. Ensure compliance with applicable environmental laws, regulations, and UGC guidelines.
8. Perform such other functions as may be assigned by the Senior Director & Dean / Director for the furtherance of environmental sustainability on campus.
