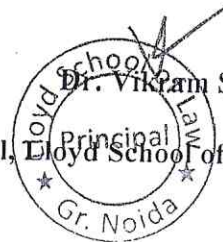
Terms of reference

1. The term of the Chairperson, members of the Committee, and the special invitee shall be of two years.
2. The quorum for the meeting, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
3. In considering the grievances before it, the committee shall follow principles of natural justice.
4. The committee shall submit its report with recommendations, if any, to the Head of the Institution with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the complaint.

Functions of Grievance Redressal Committee



1. To examine the complaints submitted by students and evaluate their benefits.
2. All the grievance brought to the notice of the committee should be handled promptly and in an unbiased manner.
3. To ensure that the grievance was properly resolved within the stipulated time.
4. To introduce a reasonable and reliable solution for grievances of various issues received from students.
