Functions of Legal Aid and Services Clinic

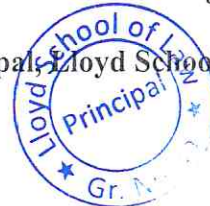
1. The Clinic shall undertake the following activities:
2. To promote awareness regarding legal rights, duties, and remedies among students and members of the community.



3. To provide assistance and guidance to persons seeking access to legal services, subject to applicable rules and the availability of authorised legal assistance.
4. To organise legal awareness camps, outreach programmes, seminars, workshops, street plays, and community-based legal literacy activities.
5. To facilitate interaction and coordination with the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), State Legal Services Authority (SLSA), practicing advocates, NGOs, and other appropriate institutions.
6. To provide students with opportunities for practical exposure to legal-aid work and community engagement under the supervision of faculty members and advocates.
7. To identify and undertake legal-awareness initiatives concerning vulnerable and disadvantaged sections of society.
8. To maintain appropriate records of the activities, cases/references, awareness programmes, and outreach initiatives undertaken by the Clinic.
9. To undertake any other activity connected with the objectives of legal aid, access to justice, legal literacy, and clinical legal education as may be approved by the competent authority.
