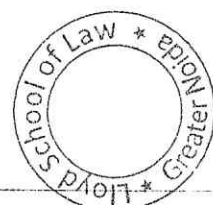
**Sub: Re-Constitution of Moot Court Society

Terms of Reference

1. The Moot Court Society shall coordinate and supervise the moot court activities of Lloyd School of Law during the Academic Year 2023-24.
2. The Society shall formulate and implement appropriate procedures for the selection, training, and participation of students in internal and external moot court competitions.
3. The Society shall work in coordination with the Principal and other faculty members for the effective conduct of moot court activities.
4. The Society shall maintain proper records and documentation of all moot court competitions, training programmes, student participation, achievements, and related activities.
5. The Society shall ensure transparency, fairness, discipline, and professionalism in the conduct of all moot court activities.





6. The Society shall periodically review the performance of participating students and provide appropriate guidance and training for improving their advocacy, research, drafting, and presentation skills.

Functions of the Moot Court Society

1. To organise and coordinate internal moot court competitions and selection rounds.
2. To facilitate and coordinate student participation in national and international moot court competitions.
3. To conduct training sessions, workshops, practice rounds, and other capacity-building activities for students.
4. To assist students in developing legal research, memorial drafting, oral advocacy, and courtroom presentation skills.
5. To select and recommend student teams for participation in external moot court competitions.
6. To coordinate communication, registration, scheduling, logistics, and other requirements relating to moot court competitions.
7. To maintain records of moot court activities, participating students, results, certificates, and achievements.
8. To ensure fair and non-arbitrary selection of students for participation in external moot court competitions.
9. To issue necessary notices, guidelines, and communications for regulating moot court activities at Lloyd School of Law.
10. To undertake any other activity necessary for promoting practical legal education and advocacy skills among students.
